ELECTRICAL NERVE STIMULATION

Electrical Nerve Stimulation can reduce pain by releasing endogenous opioids (the body's own pain relievers) or by creating a large amount of neural input to trick the brain into not noticing the pain. We also use nerve stimulation to help minimize muscle loss after some types of injuries.



REGENERATIVE MEDICINE

Regenerative medicine treats many injuries as well as osteoarthritis. It can help the patient heal, as opposed to just using drugs that mask pain. With stem cell therapy we use the patient's own stem cells, harvested from their fat cells, injecting back into the patient, most commonly into a joint or tendon. These mesenchymal stem cells are rich in substances called cytokines which promote healing and reduce inflammation. We also use platelet rich plasma which is processed from the pet's own blood. It is used alone or in conjunction with stem cells. Platelets are an amazing source of growth factors that turn off inflammation and allow the body to heal.

ACUPUNCTURE

There is a wealth of research supporting its benefits and is recognized as an effective pain relieving therapy in human medicine. Acupuncture relaxes muscles, stimulates nerves, increases blood flow, and triggers the release of natural endorphins in the body.

THERAPEUTIC LASER

Therapeutic Laser provides many benefits. Our class IV laser increases blood flow and reduces pain and swelling. It stimulates healing at the cellular level by providing energy to mitochondria, the powerhouse of the cell.



MASSAGE AND THERAPEUTIC EXERCISES

Just like us, pets love a massage! The benefits of massage include decreased scar tissue formation after injury, decreased spasms, and pain relief. We help pets develop and increase core strength through therapeutic exercises. Pets grow stronger with the use of physioballs, peanuts, cavalettis, wobble boards and NEW land treadmill.
